For the first time all Disciplines, HP, SLS and BA will be as well the EC Final.

ENTRY CRITERIA TO THE AUSTRIAN MASTERS BA - EC

- As this year the event will be held as Europe Cup FIS License is necessary to get EC Points.
- The minimum requirement to participate in Slopestyle & Big Air European Cup
- Competitions is: Minimum 10 FIS points or 75 WSPL Points in Slopestyle or Big Air
- As well riders without FIS License are welcome to collect World Rookie Rank or WSPL Points but will not get points for FIS EC or other FIS Categories.

The competition will be held under FIS Rules and regulations for Snowboard. This competition is a Snowboard Slopestyle, Big Air and Half Pipe Europe Cup and is open to both men and women. This competition will follow an official program that will be available to all participants. BIBS have to be returned immediately after the competitions. For missing BIBS € 20.- will be invoiced to each NSA after the competition. All competitors have to

wear helmets through official training, qualification and finals.

Accident Protocol: In case of accidents on courses during the event, medical personnel from the

Organizing Committee and Ski Patrol will be responsible for any medical decision

or evacuation to local hospital
